

A published author, Dr. Domnitz is particularly accomplished in the world of minimally invasive surgery, and he has been featured as a medical expert in various print publications and in segments on CBS and NBC News.

Joining Dr. Domnitz in the honors portion of the evening was the Community Honoree, the Chilton Medical Center Auxiliary.

What began in 1949 with 20 charter members has evolved into a thriving organization that continues to drive the hospital's philanthropy. Over the last half century, the auxiliary has raised more than \$6 million for Atlantic Health Chilton Medical Center.

Their efforts have funded life-saving medical equipment, expansions and modernizations, surgical innovations and vital enhancements that have impacted most every program and service provided by Atlantic Health Chilton Medical Center. Most recently, the auxiliary funded a patient treatment room in the Infusion Therapy Suite in the Oncology Department within the Collins Pavilion. Capping off the evening was the auxiliary's surprise presentation to the foundation – a check for \$30,000 from their most recent fundraising efforts.

"The foundation was so pleased to honor Dr. Domnitz and the Chilton Medical Center Auxiliary at this year's Fall for Chilton," said Megan Sandow, chief philanthropy officer. Women's Vision for Health Care Council



The Chilton Medical Center Foundation's Women's Vision for Health Care Council strives to raise awareness and inspire community philanthropy to advance exceptional health care for patients

at Atlantic Health Chilton Medical Center. Its objective is to give women a voice to help shape how health care is delivered to families in the communities that Chilton serves.

"It's important to inform, empower and support women who are the primary health care decision-makers for families, giving them the necessary tools to care for themselves and their loved ones," explained Chief Philanthropy Officer Megan Sandow. "The foundation is proud to say that the Women's Vision for Health Care Council at Atlantic Health Chilton Medical Center has made a positive difference by influencing the services and care the hospital provides the community in the areas of cancer, cardiac health, pediatrics and women's health, among others."

The council meets quarterly for educational sessions with various hospital service lines to learn more about high-priority initiatives and needs. These presentations help

guide the council to make decisions regarding funding initiatives. The council then votes on the preferred area to which it will designate its funds.

In the past 10 years, the Women's Vision for Health Care Council has designated substantial funding for cold cap therapy and integrative medicine through the Infusion Center, the Nursing Scholars Program, Rehabilitative Ultrasound Imaging, Nursing Education, the Oncology Patient Assistance Fund, the Intensive Care Unit, the Mother/Baby Unit, the Breast Center, the Cardiac Rehabilitation Center, Patient Amenity Kits, the Neuroscience/Stroke Program and the Cancer Center.

Chilton Medical Center Foundation Awards Scholarships

Each year, the Chilton Medical Center Foundation awards up to 15 \$2,500 scholarships to full- or part-time Chilton Medical Center team members who have been employed at the medical center for at least one year.

Applicants must be accepted into or currently enrolled in a full- or part-time BSN, MSN, DNP or PhD program at an accredited four-year college or university for an entire academic year and have a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
